- 5.0 **Identifying policy solutions for disinvestment**
Many communities in the CMAP region struggle with disinvestment: a pervasive and self-reinforcing combination of declining employment, population, investment, and tax base. CMAP is undertaking a two-year research project to identify intervention points in these cycles and recommend policy solutions. Initial work focuses on the prevalence, distribution, and impacts of vacancy in the region. Staff will discuss this early work and larger project goals.
